### Vineyard & Flavor Profile

*Harvest: Fall 2007*

From the bold deep stone fruit of the Lodi Petite Sirah, the cranberry brightness of the Lake County Cabernet Franc to the pretty blueberry of Syrah finished with the length on the back palate of the Old Vine Zin fruit. The layers of vineyard aromas compliment each other with a bold but balanced red wine.

### Winemaking

*Bottled: January 15, 2009*  
*Cases: 314*

Traditional fermentations followed by malo-lactic completed in French & American oak rounding out the tannins. After 16 months in barrel samples were drawn from each varietal to craft a full bodied balanced wine.
