Eric's winemaking shines through with his unique wine blending filling in a full palate experience. It's like crafting a new dish a new dish off the menu for those diners ready for a great experience, just not sure what the experience is.

Exotic rich tobacco black olives from the 65% Tempranillo, blackberry stone fruit from the 29% Old Vine Zin and mid palate depth filled in with deep dark pure fruit from only 6% Petite Sirah. The results flow with exotic notes coupled with just the right delivery of rich smooth layers of sweet tobacco, cedar, black olives with darker berry fruit complemented by undertones of oak aging.
